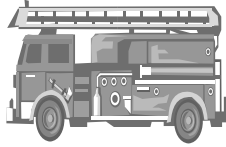


Rescue Heroes

The Trading Post will be open for business as usual with themed related item, and snacks. Breakfast will be served daily, and a brown bag lunch will be available with no cost as in the past. This year as an additional option you may purchase a hot lunch also. On Monday morning when registering you can purchase meal tickets for each of the three days at the cost of \$2.50 each day. Due to the lunches being federally funded unfortunately the parents, and helpers can not receive the free lunch so they can purchase one or bring their own lunch and coolers.

For all scouts who register up through June 7, 2008 the cost will be \$25, from June 8-30, 2008 the cost will be \$30, and after July 1, 2008 the cost will be \$30. Siblings are welcome to attend and participate, but the cost is the same as for the registered scouts regardless of the sibling's age, and a parent must stay.

Scouts are encouraged to register early so that we have enough time to properly prepare and stock up on the supplies we will be using. Don't forget to include your shirt size on your application. Parents and staff may purchase a shirt, but must be ordered and paid for in advance. Prices are: for sizes up to XL \$7, 2XL and up \$8.

Like all day camps parents are welcomed and encouraged to attend all or part of the time free of charge. This is a rain or shine event (lighting and severer storms withstanding). Please dress appropriately for the weather of that day.
