In this capacity, she lobbied on energy and environmental issues, and general business issues, on behalf of the PA Chamber's membership. Ms. Wissman has also served as Manager of Government Affairs for Embarq, formerly Sprint, a global integrated communications provider, for 11 years, with legislative responsibilities in Pennsylvania and New Jersey.

Ms. Wissman's professional affiliations and community leadership include serving as immediate past president of the Tender Years Parents Association, immediate past member of the board for the State YMCA Youth in Government program, and was an immediate past board member of the Pennsylvania Highway Information Association. She is also a member of Women in Pennsylvania Government Relations. In 2011, Governor Corbett appointed Wissman to be a member of the Underground Storage Tank Indemnification Board.
